Teaching children traffic rules is a crucial part of their education and development. Instilling these principles create a generation of responsible, safety conscious road users vital for their safety and well-being.

NPS- Kengeri Junior Wing organized a traffic set-up for children, creating a simulated environment to enlighten about traffic rules and safety in a hands-on, interactive way for students. Children could experience real-life traffic situations in a controlled and safe setting. The components included miniature roadways, traffic signal and signs, pedestrian crossing and roundabouts.

Children practiced navigating through different traffic scenarios and respond to appropriate signal. They enacted in different roles as drivers, pedestrians, traffic police to understand their perspectives and responsibilities. They used cut outs of vehicles, trucks to navigate traffic environment giving them a real life driving experience. Helmets, reflective clothing and seat belts are introduced to emphasize the importance of safety equipment.

School traffic setup reinforces confidence fostering a collaborative approach building connection between school and wider community.
